WHAT DOES A “SONG FOR ONE WORLD” MEAN TO US?

We're looking for songs that address themes of global development, that is focus on issues that affect people in different parts of the world. Are there any such topics that particularly concern you – for example, social justice, peace, climate protection or the issue of how we can treat one another with greater tolerance and fairness? No doubt many other topics come to mind from your day to day life that you likewise consider crucial to our coexistence on this planet and which you'd like to share with others. What's important is maintaining a global perspective too and considering the relevance of your topic e.g. to people in Africa, Asia, Europe or Latin America.

CHECK LIST:

Participants

- ✓ may be aged between 10 and 25

The song

- ✓ must have a maximum length of 3:50 minutes
- ✓ does not need instrumental accompaniment

The lyrics

- ✓ has to pick up on the “ONE WORLD” or “global development” topics,
- ✓ should be written in a clear, comprehensible language,
- ✓ and stand out its artistic value (choice of words, images, structure and style) and originality

The music will be evaluated according to

- ✓ the musicality (expressive, sensitive and nuanced interpretation),
- ✓ voice performance,
- ✓ composition,
- ✓ development potential

YOU CAN WIN GREAT PRIZES!

There are money and material prizes to be won, and all participants will receive a personal certificate from the German Federal Minister for Economic Cooperation and Development.

1. PRIZE: Your song will be the EINE WELT song and will be the anthem accompanying the 11th round of the German Federal President's School Competition on Development Policy. Your song will be professionally produced in the studio and will prominently feature on the EINE WELT album. In addition you will win a professional music video shoot and a cash prize of 1,000 euros.

2TH TO 5TH PRIZE: The second to fifth placed participants also win 1,000 euros per entry. Furthermore the songs will be professionally produced in the studio for the EINE WELT album.

6TH TO 20TH PRIZE: The songs will be professionally produced in the studio and will appear on the EINE WELT album!

SPECIAL PRIZE AFRICA & COOPERATIVE COLLABORATION:

If you created your song in cooperative collaboration with participants from countries of the Global South, you qualify for one of the two special prizes, each with a cash prize of 1,000 euros. These songs will also be produced in the studio. For the Africa Special Prize, the content of the song must reference the continent of Africa as well as having a global perspective, and furthermore it must be submitted in cooperation with African participants or from participants from the region.

SPECIAL PRIZE FOR THE BEST SONG LYRICS: Do you like getting to the heart of the matter and is lyric writing your strong suit? Then this special prize is perfect for you because it is for the best lyrics. You can win a prize of 1,000 euros.

PUBLIC'S PRIZE: Mobilise your fans for the user voting. Win your place on the EINE WELT album (ONE WORLD album), and the studio production of your song.

RECOGNITION PRIZES Another ten songs and places 2 to 5 in the user voting will win a cash prize of 100 euros.

WHO WILL VOTE?

After the official closing date for entries, all published songs can be accessed on the website for user voting purposes. Users can vote for their favourite songs for a period of three weeks. The song with the most votes wins the Public's Prize!

In an internal selection procedure, a total of 30 Songs songs as well as up to five finalist songs for the special prizes will be determined by a preliminary jury. From this selection, an independent main jury (experts in the education, music and media fields) will then select the special and recognition awards, the songs for the EINE WELT album (ONE WORLD album) and a top 5 selection for the main prizes. Then the top 5 candidates will present their songs in a live performance before the main jury, which will then determine the EINE WELT song (ONE WORLD song).

THE SONG CONTEST

The "Dein Song für EINE WELT!" (Your Song for ONE WORLD) Song Contest is organised by Engagement Global gGmbH - Service für Entwicklungsinitiativen on behalf of the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development. The song contest was launched in 2015 to accompany the School Competition on Development Policy, and has since then been held every two years. Following the fantastic response to the fourth competition with around 600 songs entered by 2,300 young people, we are now looking forward to your song in the latest round! Tell the world about the global issues that matter to you and make yourself heard through music!
